All I remember of the contest is that the second-place finisher wanted this record real bad but he had to settle for a bobblehead.




I'm the Man Who Loves You Wilco 3:56

The answer to these questions is the chorus of this song.




Keep 'Em on They Toes Brent Cobb 2:44
